



GENERAL GUIDELINES for CHAMPIONING a BENEFICIARY

Pursuant to the Friends of Jack bylaws and determination of non-profit 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status, Friends of Jack provides support to a fallen rider who has an accident while cycling. The objective of Friends of Jack's monetary contribution is to make the landing as soft as possible so that riders can heal, without shortening their focus on recovery, and return to life activity when they are able to sustain themselves.

To receive support from Friends of Jack a fallen rider must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- (a) Not have medical/health insurance at the time of the incident.
- (b) Have medical/health insurance but a shortfall meeting medical expenses.
- (c) Have medical/health insurance but no funds to sustain themselves while recovering.
- (d) In addition to one of the above criteria a-c, the accident causes the individual to miss work or precludes them from working because their incident keeps them from immediately going back to earning their living.

To make a request for support, contact a Board Member or Friends of Jack directly. The Board will consider requests and make decisions regarding allocations as needed. Attach additional pages as appropriate.
